BIOGRAPHY OF ELON MUSK

CHILDHOOD: Musk was born on June 28,1971 in Pretoria, Transvaal, South Africa, the son of Maye Musk & Errol Musk, a South African electromechanical engineer, pilot and sailor.

He had a younger brother, Kimbal and a younger sister, Tosca. He lived with his father after parents split in 1980 and relations were bitter. During his childhood he was an avid reader. At the age of 10, he developed an interest in computer with Commodore VIC-20. He taught himself Computer Programming at the age of 12. Musk attended the English speaking water loof House Preparatory School and later graduated from Pretoria Boys High School.

EXTRAORDINARY: At the age of 17, in 1989, Elon Musk moved to Canada to attend Queen's Unit 1999, Musk Co-founded X.com named as Paypal it is just like Pay team in India and in a very short time aw thousand users multiplying to more than 1 million in a few months.

ROAD TO SUCCESS: In October 2002, Pay Pal was acquired by eBay. Musk had begun to dream experimental green house that he could land on Mars. The green house, which he called "Mars. Dasis". Musk founded his third company, Space Exploration Technologies Corporation, or Space X, in 2002 with the intention of building space craft for commercial space travel.

SPACE X: Musk founded Space Exploration Technologies, or Space X, in May 2002. Musk is chief executive officer (CEO) and (CTO) of the Hawthorne, California based company.

Space X develops and manufactures space launch vehicles with a focus on advancing the States of rocket technology. The company's first two launch vehicles are:-FALCON 1 & FALCON 9 Its first spacecraft is the Dragon.

2006, Space X was awarded a contract from NASA to continue the development.

In early 2012, approximately two-thirds of the company were owned by its founder.

Space X currently operates three orbital launch sites, at Cape Canaveral, Vandenberg Air Force

Base, and Kennedy Space Center, and have announced plans for a fourth in Browns-ville, Texas.






